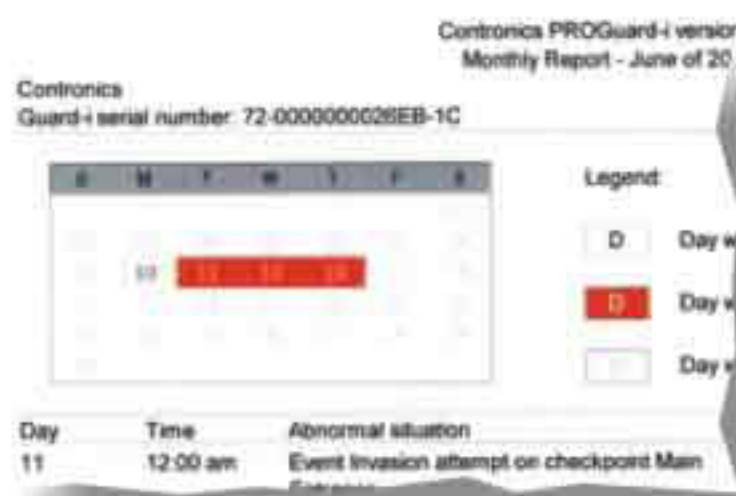

Reports

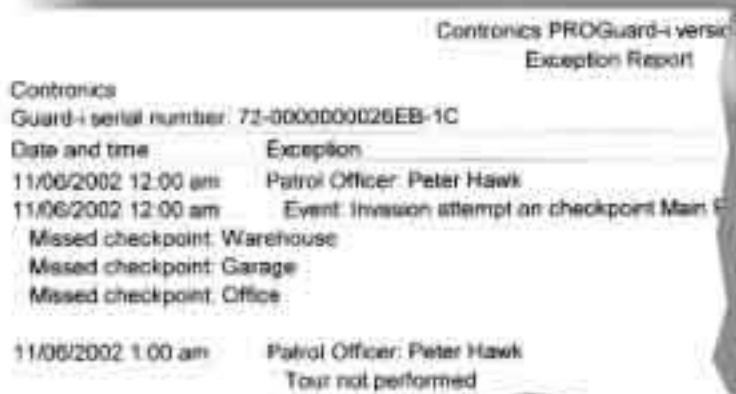
PROGuard-i generates different types of reports with enables the user to make a thorough check of the information obtained and also makes searching for specific data fast and easy.

All reports are of easy visualization and interpretation, and cannot be edited in their original form. The reports contain the **Guard-i** identification number and the date and time of each reading, as well as additional information that varies according to the reports printed.



Monthly Report

By using the Monthly Report the user can quickly check which days had tour problems and also what these problems were, with the help of a monthly calendar. These alterations may be incomplete rounds, rounds not carried out, events recorded by the **Numeric Button Key Pad** and also time intervals in which **Guard-i** wasn't operating. This report can be filtered, by classifying the data according to the date, patrol officer or the type of occurrence.



Exception Report

Just like the Monthly Report, this Exception Report shows alterations in rounds, but with two main differences: the report is not bound to a monthly period and a greater number of details is displayed. If there is an incomplete round, the Exception Report will indicate which sites the patrol officer failed to check, for instance.



Activity Map Report

This report shows an overview of the tours performed over the period of one month, in a more visual manner, showing the time each checkpoint was visited, or a blank space in case that checkpoint was skipped. These blank spaces account for a fast and easy visual identification of tours that were not performed or incomplete rounds.



Full Report

Full reports are complete logs of everything recorded by a **Guard-i**. Here you find a list of all the buttons that have been touched by **Guard-i**, as well as all situations that it may signal by light or sound. Just like both the Monthly and the Exceptions Reports, the Full Report can be filtered according to the patrol officer, the date of the tours and may or may not include the events recorded by the **Numeric Button Key Pad**.



Frequency Report

The Frequency Report shows how often buttons have been touched by **Guard-i**. The date and time of each reading are also listed, along with the internal code, the description informed by the user, and a reference and/or a unit (in case of events), all corresponding to any recorded button. This report offers a more comprehensive filtering resource, therefore enabling the user to obtain the most varied combinations of information in a fast and simplified manner.



Programming Report

This report indicates how **Guard-i** has been programmed. This report does not allow any filtering, but the user may change the programmable settings of **Guard-i**.

The "Monthly", "Exception", "Activity Map", "Full", and "Frequency" Reports may be exported into text format (.txt) to other programs or applications.
